In his article, "Arms & Self Defense," Pastor Emry just about covered all the bases as to Christians being justified in arming themselves and inflicting violence upon Christ's enemies.

Through the years we have dealt mainly with hypothetical situations, such as a "Red Dawn" situation with enemy troops parachuting from the skies. However, today, we are facing real-life situations.

In past years we have thought about the use of guns from a John Rambo view point. We, somehow, assumed our enemy would be wearing distinct uniforms and present clear, easy targets.

If we haven't found out already, we will soon learn that our enemy wears business suits, carries attache cases and looks, surprisingly, like everyone else!

The only uniforms you'll see will be some SWAT team wearing their "Darth Vader" best or our own military!

Did Randy Weaver's wife and son die in some "Red Dawn scenario? No, his wife died at the hands of a cowardly FBI sniper, Ron Horiuchi.



While this coward murdered Vicky Weaver as she held a nursing baby, Federal marshals shot Weaver's 14 year old son in the back after killing his dog!

Did the women and children at Waco, die at the hands of foreign troops? No, they were cremated alive by our own FBI and ATF, under orders from then-attorney general, Janet Reno (old shake & bake) and Bill Clinton!

Several years ago, I held a Federal Firearms License that allowed me to design and manufacture machine guns and silencers. At the same time I was publishing both SWAT and Firepower magazines. This activity put me in close proximity to a lot of questionable things done by "our side."

I feel this needs addressing as an aid to our remnant people, to keep them from doing something dumb that could place them in legal harm's way, while accomplishing little to nothing.

Earlier, I mentioned Ruby Ridge and Randy Weaver. This whole bloody mess began when Randy, at the request of an agent provocateur, sawed a shotgun barrel off 3/4 of an inch too short. As the law is written, a shotgun must meet 2 dimensional requirements:

1. The barrel must be at least 18 inches (measured from the closed bolt face to muzzle, and:
2. The overall length from the butt of the stock to the muzzle must not be shorter than 26 inches.

There are only two reasons for having a shortened shotgun: ease of concealment and navigating a house, while using for defensive purposes. Police “riot” shotguns usually have a 20 inch barrel, with the stock of sufficient length for shooting from the shoulder. By shortening the barrel 8 inches, this gun can be used inside a house without doing a “trapeze act” going through a doorway.

In Weaver’s case, this 3/4 inch of shotgun barrel placed him in a vulnerable position to the Feds. They proceeded to offer him a chance to avoid prosecution for the illegal shotgun if he would infiltrate the Aryan Brotherhood for them. He refused and the rest is history!

The point I want to make is this whole sorry mess was due to Weaver’s initial stupidity in sawing off 3/4 of an inch too much shotgun barrel.

As a former magazine publisher, I was approached more than one time by someone who wanted me to publish a story about how the ATF had abused them. On the surface, it appeared that they had suffered an injustice. However, upon a closer look, every one of them

had, initially, done something really stupid.

It is common practice for federal law enforcement to entrap someone, who can, once compromised, be forced into infiltrating their intended target, usually some organization of interest.

Speaking of organizations — avoid any and all such groups who openly meet, wear some sort of uniform or display by hair cut, tattoos, etc., their ego building attitudes.

I am highly suspect that many of these groups are even, secretly, financed by the enemy. Circumstantial evidence indicates that certain anti-Communist groups have been (unknown to even their top leadership) secretly funded and promoted by the ADL or some other ally of the Federal Government.

Is it a normal procedure for aspiring totalitarian regimes to purposely form small opposition groups, merely to have a “finger” in all the pies! These serve as “listening posts” to learn the real feelings of their future subjects. With the intelligence thus provided, they can then adjust their own agendas accordingly, for maximum effect.

Federal law enforcement are capable of creating “organizations;” however, they are, also, quick to infiltrate existing ones. Because of the rampant stupidity displayed in some of these groups, it is an easy chore to do.

Once infiltration has been accomplished, it provides a secondary benefit as a point to inject disinformation.

So, in closing, I want to re-emphasize the need to avoid any such organizations as we have described above.

At the same time, assess your own security situation and quietly modify, if necessary. Remember — your security is inversely proportional to the square of the number of people involved.

Example: The best situation is when you are the only person involved. If you are allied with only 3 other people, your security is worsened by a factor of 16!
