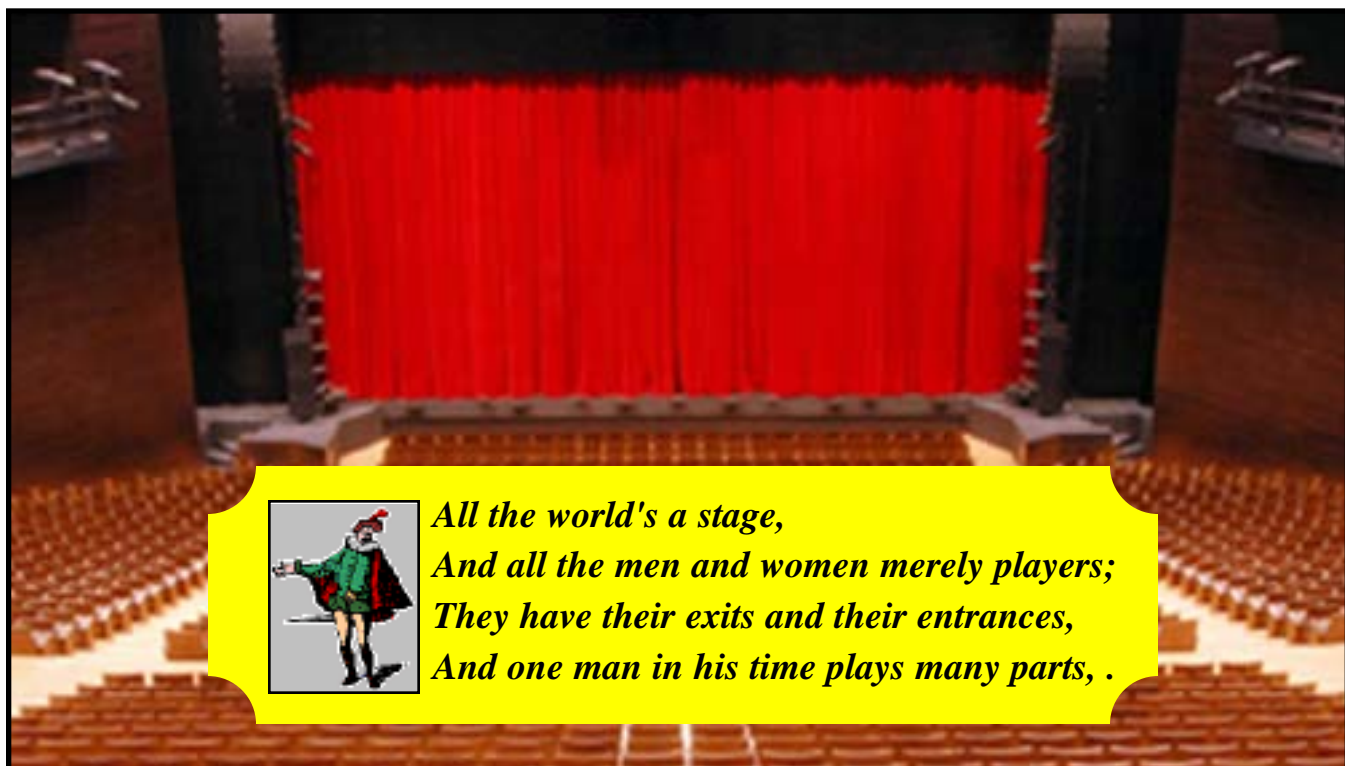


# Theater

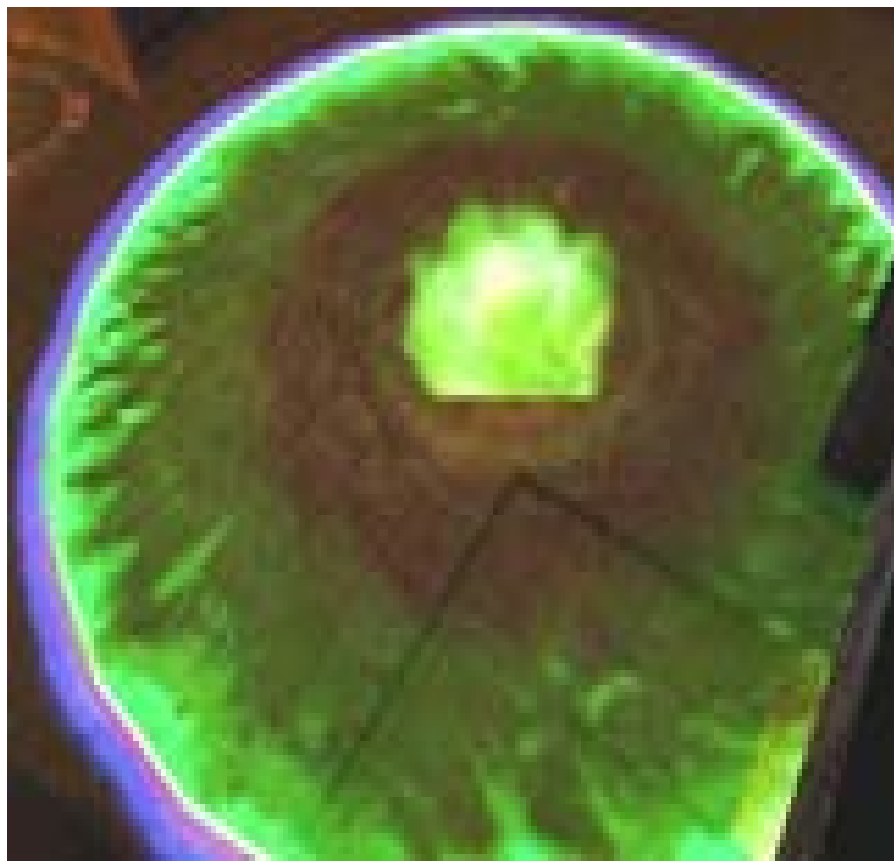
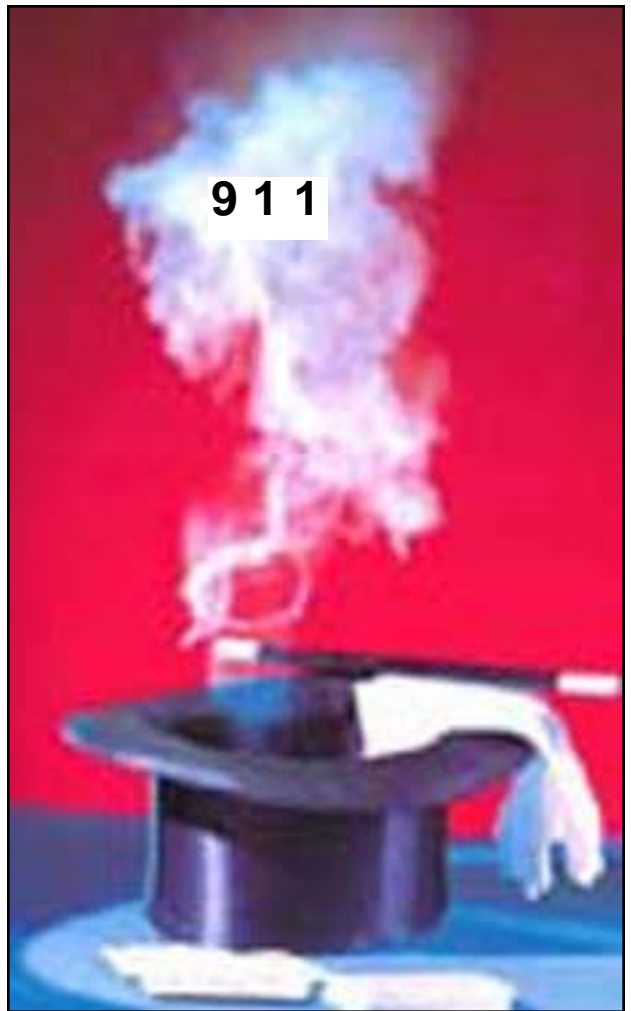
